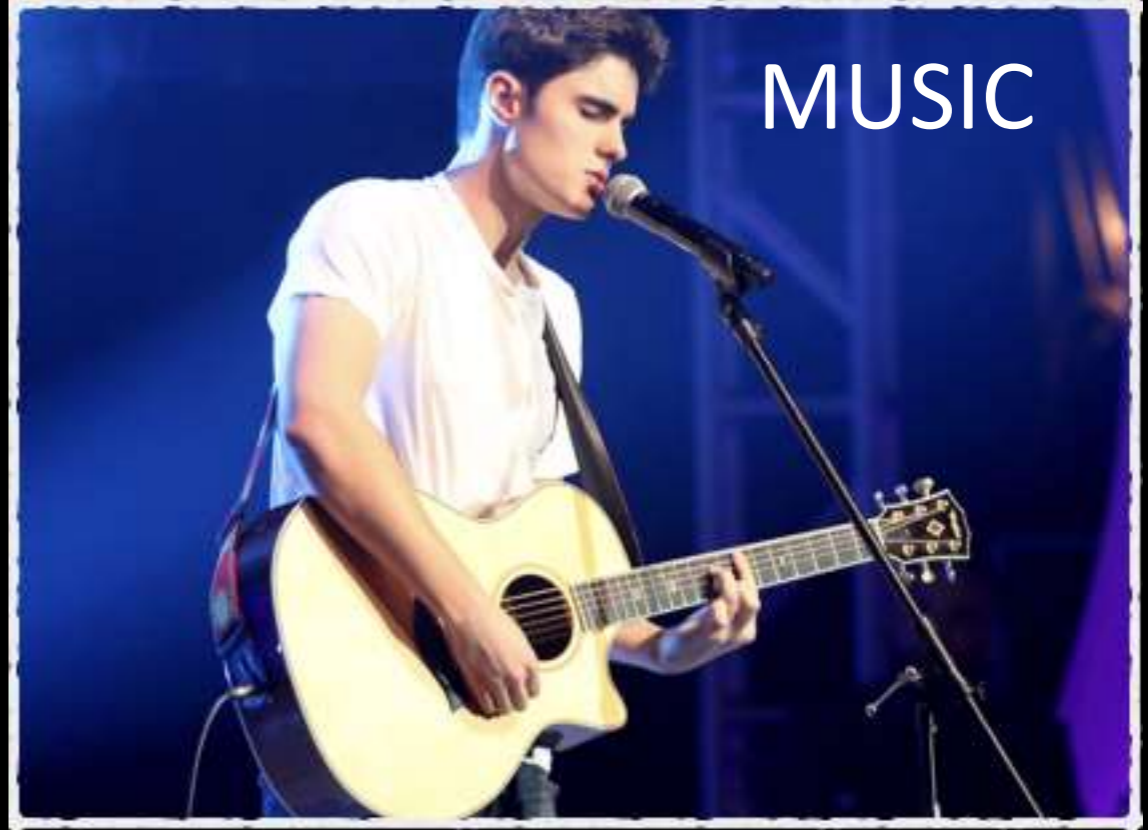
Elevate International History

- 2010 Launched Remix (Young adult retreat), Camp Elevate reaches 600 participants, Missions partnership in Haiti

- 2011 Missions partnership in Puerto Rico, Launched Inward (Young ladies mentorship program),
- 2012 Changed name to Elevate International, Host National Day of Prayer at AZ state capitol,
- 2013 Launched 13-D, launched Rise (Young men mentorship program)
- 2014 Launched I-Do (Married ministry), Launched Youth Council, Launched School of Business and Entrepreneurship
